Home Care can be difficult to navigate. Not only must providers manage a consumer's needs and expectations within their budget, providers must ensure they are complying with legislation and guidelines to ensure that the services provided and items purchased with a package are not out of scope.

The legislation briefly sets out the criteria for what is allowed to be purchased using Home Care funding, however practically, it can be very difficult for providers to interpret and adhere to the legislation particularly in light of the evolving interpretation by the industry and regulators.
